Children's Speech, Hearing, and Occupational Therapy Services



Children's Speech Services

Early Intervention Group and Individual Therapy

Early identification and treatment of disorders can help children with communication, reading, writing, and social skills. We provide programs for preschoolers, school-aged children, and young adolescents.

Craniofacial Clinic in Partnership with CHOC Children's

As a member of the CHOC cleft palate and craniofacial team, our expert speech-language pathologists work with medical teams to assess and monitor each child's development to improve their overall speech intelligibility.

Aural Rehabilitation

Hearing loss in infancy or early childhood can affect all aspects of speech and language development. Our therapy includes training auditory perception, improving speech, and developing language and family support.

Social Skills Program for Pragmatic Language Disorders

Develops appropriate communicative behavior, including asking questions; expressing ideas, wants and needs; accepting suggestions; identifying emotions; monitoring body language and personal space; and listening.

Talk2 Aural Habilitation Program

This program for the whole family emphasizes the use of residual hearing through an amplification device, while enhancing skills in sound detection, discrimination, identification, and comprehension.

Speech Therapy for Autism Spectrum Disorder

Helps children with ASD develop functional communication skills and learn appropriate social interaction and play skills. Also emphasizes education and training for parents.



Children's Hearing Services

Advanced Hearing Services for Children

Our tests include play and/or visual reinforcement audiometry and a full range of hearing evaluations. We also provide hearing aid fittings, repair and maintenance, and a loaner program.

Tympanometry and Acoustic Reflex

These tests measure and diagnose middle-ear function and can detect fluid in the middle ear, negative middle-ear pressure and disruption of the ossicles, tympanic membrane perforation, and otosclerosis.

Otoacoustic Emission (OAE)

This test is used to measure auditory ability in infants and patients who may not cooperate with routine testing. OAE uses a soft probe in the ear canal to measure the echo sounds emitting from within the inner ear.

Auditory Brainstem Response (ABR)

This test assesses the hearing thresholds of young children and the functionality of the auditory neural pathway.

ABR Clinic

In partnership with CHOC Children's, our audiologists offer an ABR clinic for children who require sedation for accurate testing and diagnosis.

Central Auditory Processing Disorder (cAPD)

Our audiology and speech teams evaluate a child's auditory and language skills using repeated words or sentences in complex listening environments.

Real Ear Measurement

This series of tests shows how a hearing aid can improve a patient's hearing loss by comparing overall volume and areas of amplification with and without the hearing aid.

Ear Mold and Swimming Plug Fittings

We offer customizable ear molds, noise protectors and swim molds in an assortment of colors, styles and textures.

Orange County Cochlear Implant Institute™

At the first all-encompassing cochlear implant center in Orange County, we provide a full range of services for patients who need or have cochlear implants. These services include complete diagnostics and evaluations, implant mapping, and related speech therapies.

Occupational Therapy Services

Occupational Therapy for Children

Helps children ages 2 to 5 explore and interact with their environment using sensory integration and other techniques. Our program addresses leisure/play, social participation, daily activities, feeding and dressing skills, and education.

Pediatric Feeding and Swallowing

Feeding and swallowing problems in children are complex and surprisingly common. Our comprehensive approach is designed to support optimal growth and development. We offer treatment programs for infants, toddlers, preschoolers and school-aged children, and our therapy includes family support to encourage continued treatment at home.
